Rebuilding Together Program



Creating a safe living environment is a critical step toward healthy aging. Suddenly a rug that has covered the floor for years is a potential hazard, or reaching for an item that has always been on the top shelf is difficult. Attention to detail can enable an individual to continue living at home longer, comfortably and independently.

MPTF's Rebuilding Together and Home Safe Home programs respond to important home safety needs. Home Safe Home addresses minor home repairs and improvements, while Rebuilding Together tackles the larger ones. An MPTF representative provides a private home safety assessment free of charge and identifies possible improvements and repairs. If agreed upon, MPTF will coordinate skilled volunteers from our entertainment community to do the work. Clients may also select non-volunteer labor.

Even small improvements can pay BIG dividends in safety and peace of mind.

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*Improvements may be made by volunteers, depending on eligibility, or by a professional resource of a client's choosing.

Interior Assessments Include:

- Bathrooms, Bedrooms and Kitchens
- Floors, Doors, Hallways, Stairs
- Lighting
- Extensions Cords, Smoke Alarms, Lifeline (PERS)

Exterior Assessments Include:

- Lighting
- Hand Rails and Steps
- Walkways and Ramps

Recommended Safety Improvements May Include:

- Bath Mats
- Bed Poles
- Commode Rug
- Grab Bars
- Hand-held Shower
- Hand Rails
- Night Lights
- Peep Holes
- Raised Toilet Seats
- Ramps
- Transfer Bench
- Tub Rail
- Tub Seat
